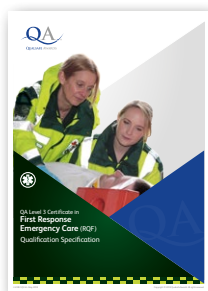

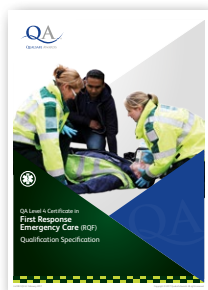


QA Level 3 Certificate in First Response Emergency Care (RQF)

The QA Level 3 Certificate in First Response Emergency Care (RQF) is perfect for those seeking a career in the emergency services, ambulance service, the event and security medical sector or those who work in high risk workplaces.

Over a 5 day period, learners will gain the knowledge, skills and competencies needed to deal with a range of prehospital care emergencies, such as: managing a patient's airway, catastrophic bleeding, management of fractures, medical emergencies and more.

Fulfilling the competencies set out in the PHEM skills framework at descriptor level D, this fantastic qualification is also endorsed by The Faculty of Pre-Hospital Care – The Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh.

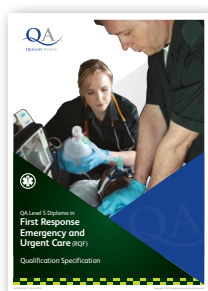


QA Level 4 Certificate in First Response Emergency Care (RQF)

The QA Level 4 Certificate in First Response Emergency Care (RQF) is specifically designed for those looking to progress their career within the NHS or private ambulance services as an emergency care assistant, intermediate ambulance practitioner, event medical provider, associate practitioner or healthcare assistant.

As the next step for those who have completed the QA Level 3 Certificate in First Response Emergency Care (RQF) or equivalent, this qualification provides learners with a wider scope of practice in prehospital care emergencies, allowing for greater employment opportunities.

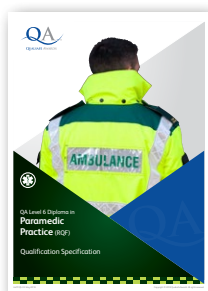

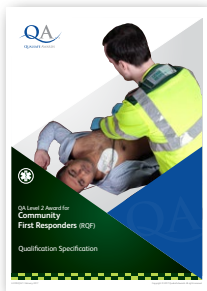

Successful candidates will be equipped with the knowledge, skills and competencies needed to be able to manage a range of prehospital care situations, covering topics such as: bioscience for Paramedics, clinical assessment and treatment skills, as well as advanced trauma life support and more.



QA Level 2 Award for Community First Responders (RQF)



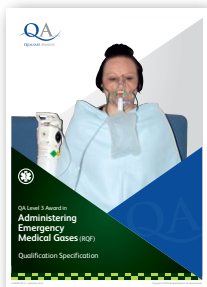

Over a 2 day period, learners will cover a range of topics required to deal with prehospital care emergencies, such as: managing a patient's airway, administering emergency oxygen, managing major illness and much more.



QA Level 3 Award in Administering Emergency Medical Gases (RQF)



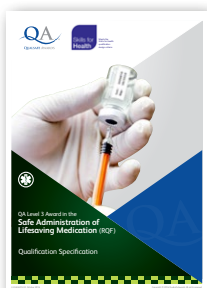

The QA Level 3 Award in Administering Emergency Medical Gases (RQF) has been specifically designed for those who have a responsibility for providing treatment to patients who need medical gases administering in prehospital care environments, such as those working in the police force, fire service or private ambulance sector.

During this half day course, learners will develop the necessary knowledge and skills needed for the safe, prompt and effective administration of emergency oxygen and analgesic agents.

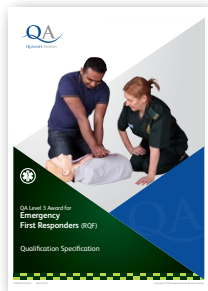

Successful learners will leave the course equipped with all of the knowledge, skills and competencies needed to administer lifesaving medication safely and effectively in a prehospital environment.

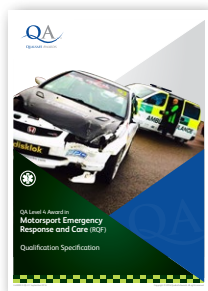


QA Level 3 Award for Emergency First Responders (RQF)

 2 day course  Certificate valid for 3 years

The QA Level 3 Award for Emergency First Responders (RQF) is ideal for those who are likely to be responding to an emergency incident, including: community first responders, emergency services personnel, event medical responders, cabin crew and first aiders.

Successful learners will gain the necessary knowledge and skills required to deal with a range of prehospital care emergencies, such as: managing a patient's airway, dealing with catastrophic bleeding and managing major illnesses.

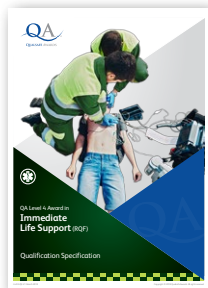


QA Level 4 Award in Motorsport Emergency Response and Care (RQF)

 2 day course  Certificate valid for 3 years

The QA Level 4 Award in Motorsport Emergency Response and Care (RQF) has been designed for emergency care providers such as Medical Technicians, Ambulance Technicians, Paramedics, Nurses and Doctors who have a specific responsibility for providing emergency care at motorsport events.

During this comprehensive course, learners will study a range of topics, including motorsport safety protocols and regulations, how to assess motorsport incidents, as well as how to treat, immobilise and extricate patients from the scene.



QA Level 4 Award in Immediate Life Support (RQF)

 1 day course  Certificate valid for 1 year

The QA Level 4 Award in Immediate Life Support (RQF) enables learners to develop their knowledge and skills in providing immediate life support to patients in cardiorespiratory arrest or experiencing life-threatening illness and injury.

This regulated and nationally recognised qualification is ideal for those who have a specific responsibility at work, or in voluntary and community activities, to provide emergency care to patients, such as event medical providers, emergency ambulance personnel, registered healthcare professionals and those working in specialist roles within the emergency services and military.



QA Level 4 Award in Mentoring Ambulance and Emergency Services Personnel (RQF)

 3 day course  Certificate remains valid by maintaining a CPD portfolio

The QA Level 4 Award in Mentoring Ambulance and Emergency Services Personnel (RQF) is ideal for experienced ambulance and emergency services personnel who are looking to progress their careers by gaining the skills required to become a mentor, supervisor or team leader responsible for learning and development in the workplace.

Over a 3 day period, learners will gain the knowledge and skills needed to effectively support and mentor those working towards qualifications where mentored practice is required, covering topics such as: understanding the benefits and different types of mentoring, giving appropriate feedback, identifying personal and professional development opportunities and much more.
